The reserve squad, although hard workers and scrappy, lack the height and experience to be a serious contender in the Rosebud Conference next year.



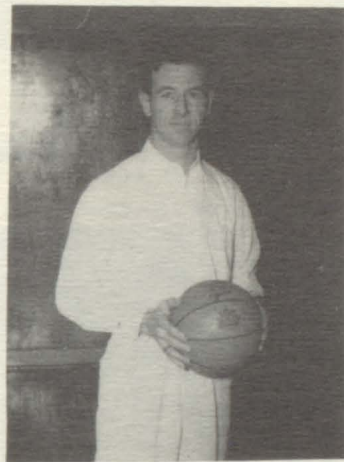
