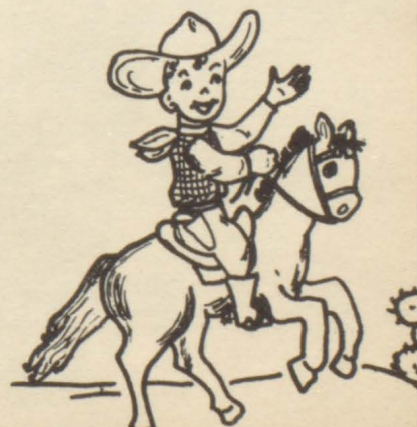


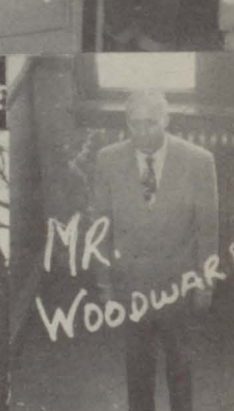
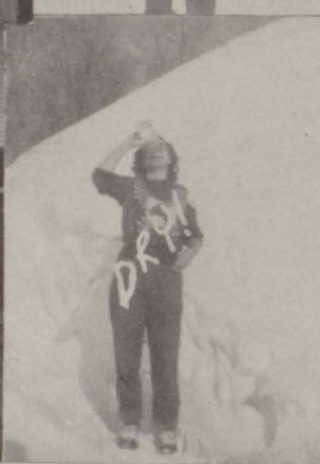
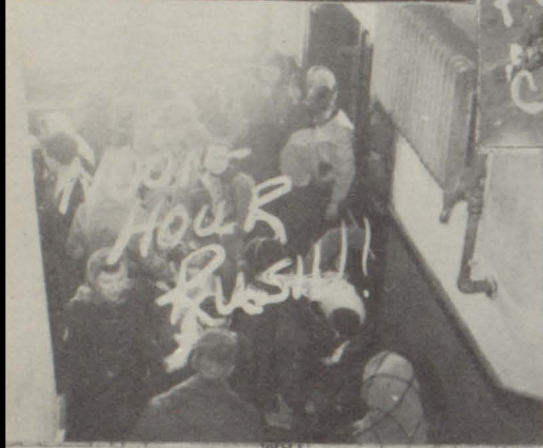
The dorm was again under the supervision of Mr. and Mrs. Jeffords.
