Mr. Uken and four of his sophomore students are finding the biology specimens very interesting.





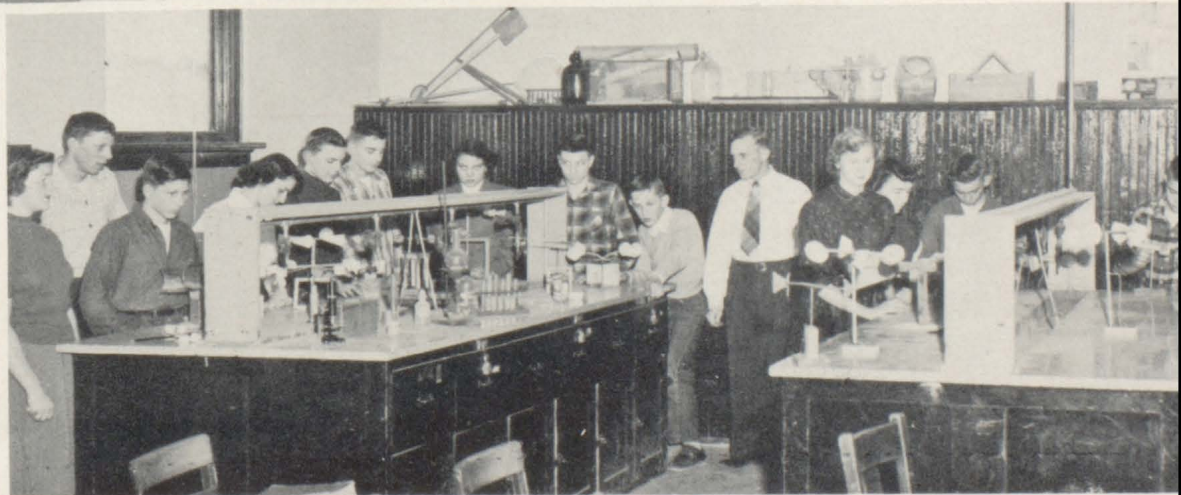
Searching for an unknown quantity in a maze of letters and figures occupies the minds of the Algebra students and teacher Mrs. Gretschmann.
