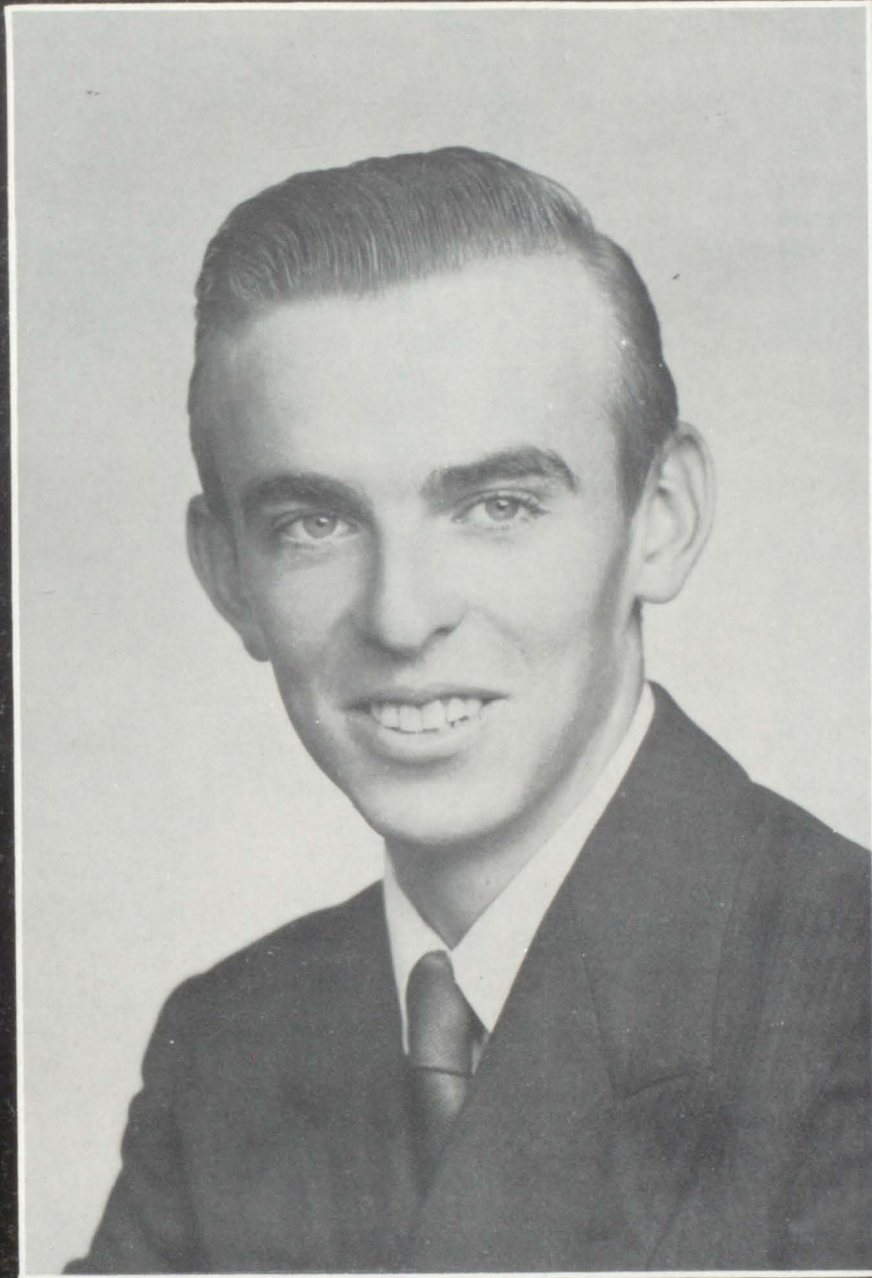
To Shirley Mae Musilek in memory of her high school years, we the staff, proudly dedicate our 1960 Cowboy Annual.
