The finale--a glorious graduation and a party never to be forgotten!

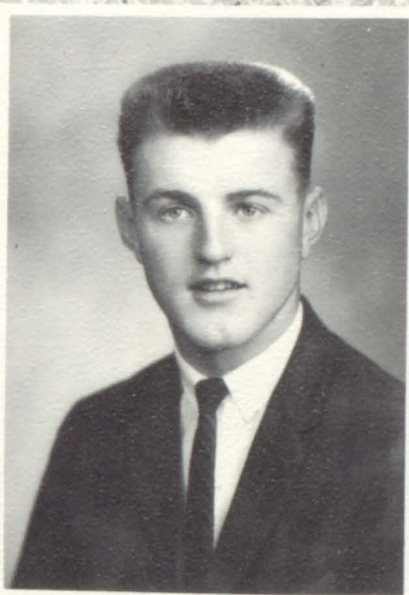
