
The students spent many hours during the Homecoming week working diligently on their floats. With no main theme, the designs ranged from the election to food.

Allan Patton, Dick Kaiser, Dan Kaiser, and Craig Stenson composed the two-mile relay which set a new record. Each man runs a half mile.





