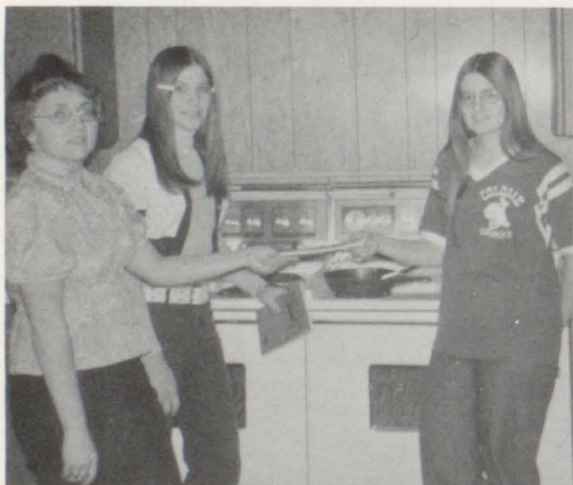
Good Times

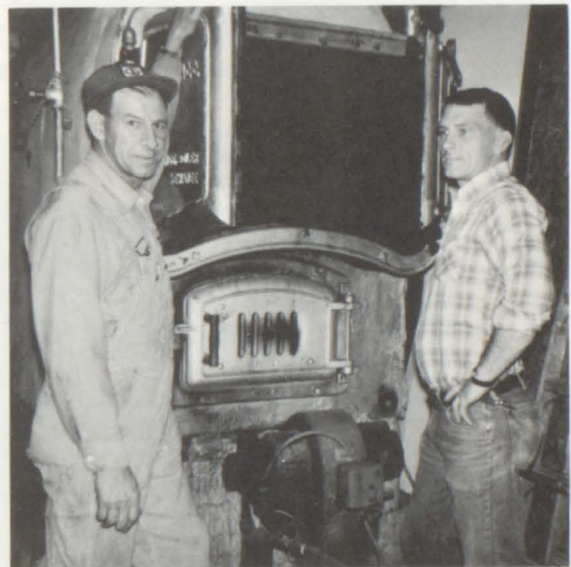
Special People

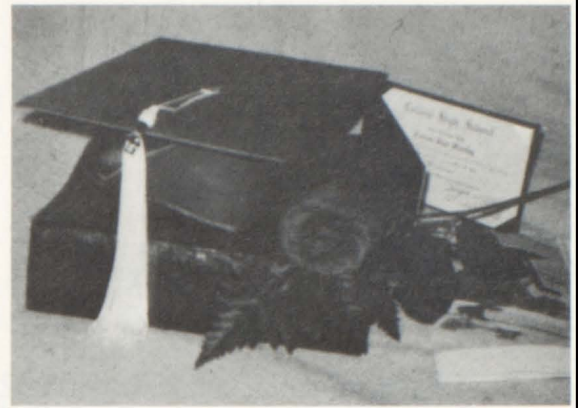
