The "76'ers" took second place with "Hey, Hey, Hey, The Cowboys are, Okay".



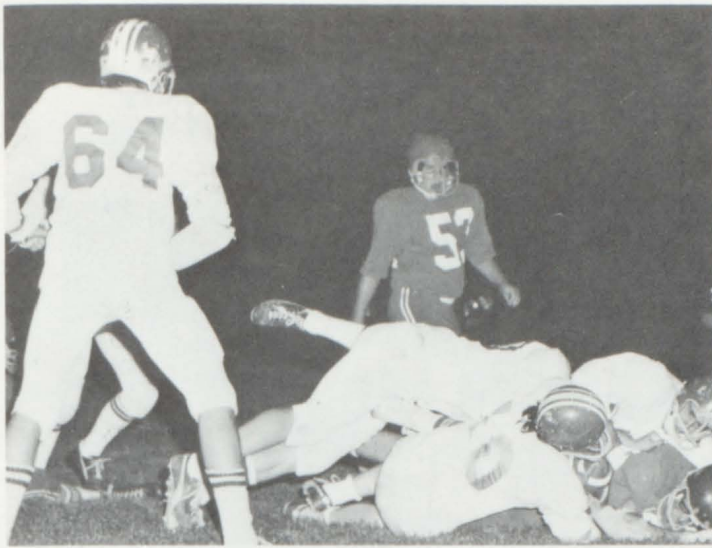

Mr. Ralph Plas, our superintendent, has to face many headaches, but he always figures out just what to do. We are glad for his services for making the school run like a charm.



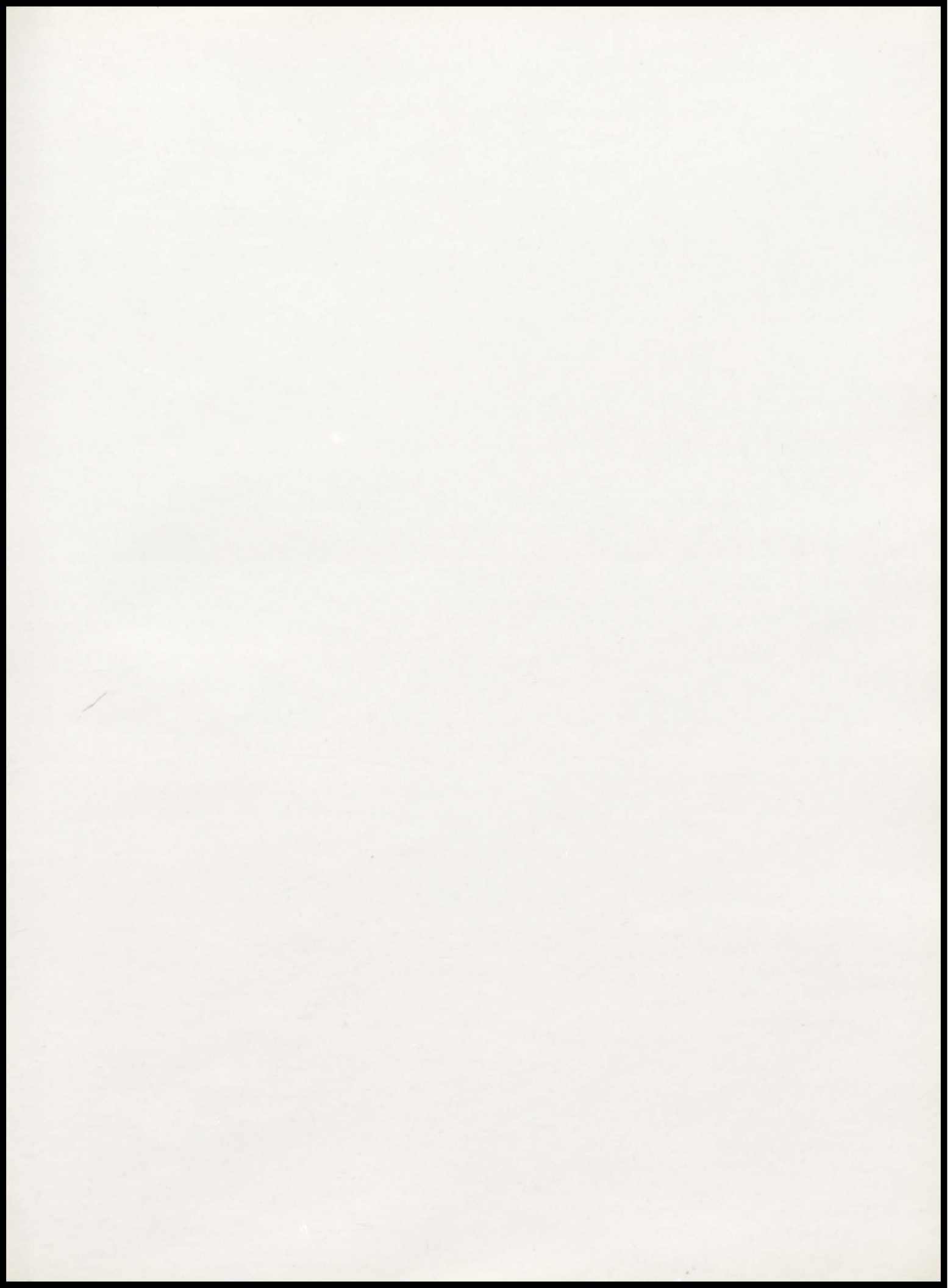
