


This year we would like to dedicate our annual to Mr. Robert Scheinost.

The game started at 7:30 at Fetzner field. We hosted Delmont and it was a very good game with the score ending at 41 to 8 the Cowboys being the victors.











Good job Cowboys!!







We have also tried to come up with a few new ideas which are very interesting.









The "B" Team also had a winning season with a record of 10 wins and 6 losses.














Districts


