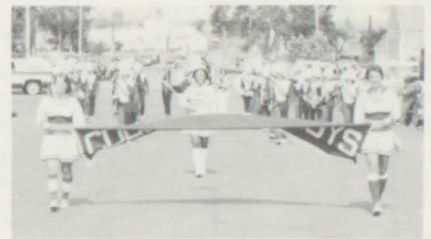
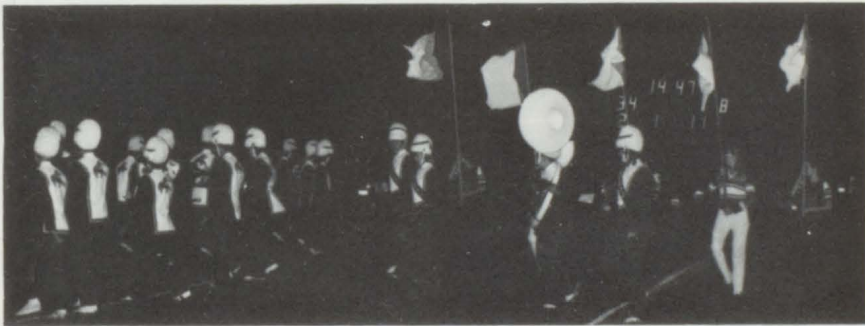
Mr. Scheinost has done a fine job serving on the School Board since 1967. In 1967 he was appointed Chairman of the Board and still maintains that position.

The game started at 7:30 at Fetzner field. We hosted Delmont and it was a very good game with the score ending at 41 to 8 the Cowboys being the victors.

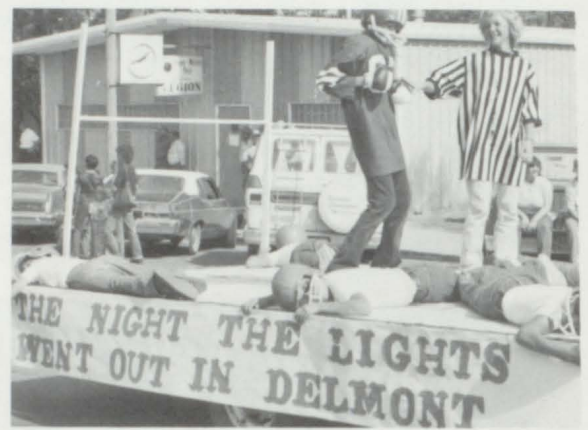

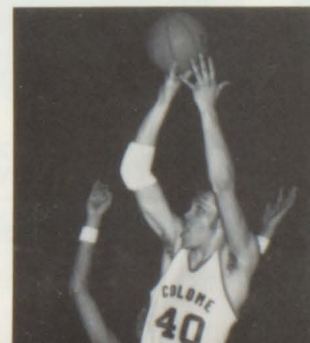
Districts
