COWGIRL BASKETBALL

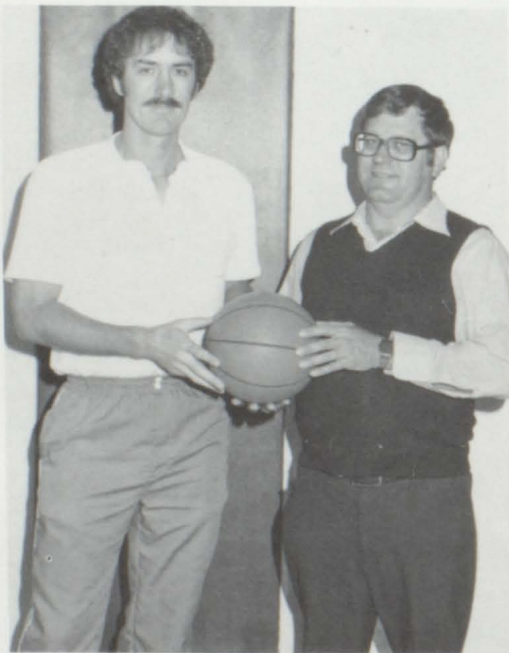

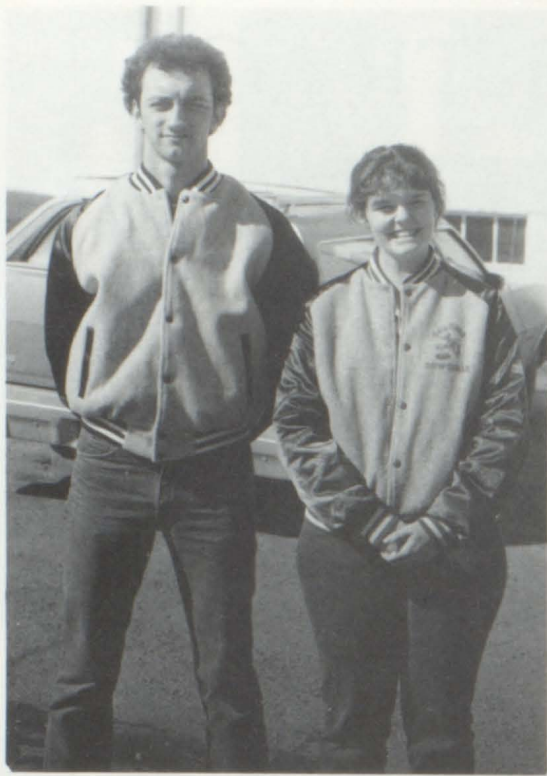
