
Friday dawned rainy, but the spirits of the fans weren't dampened. A good crowd showed up at the football game that night to cheer on the Cowboys.






The 1986-87 Cowboy Basketball season was a successful and exciting season. The team finished with a 10 win 8 loss season.




This year was the beginning of Cowgirl Volleyball! The team was not as successful as they were hoping to be, but they had a lot of fun and learned quite a bit, too.
