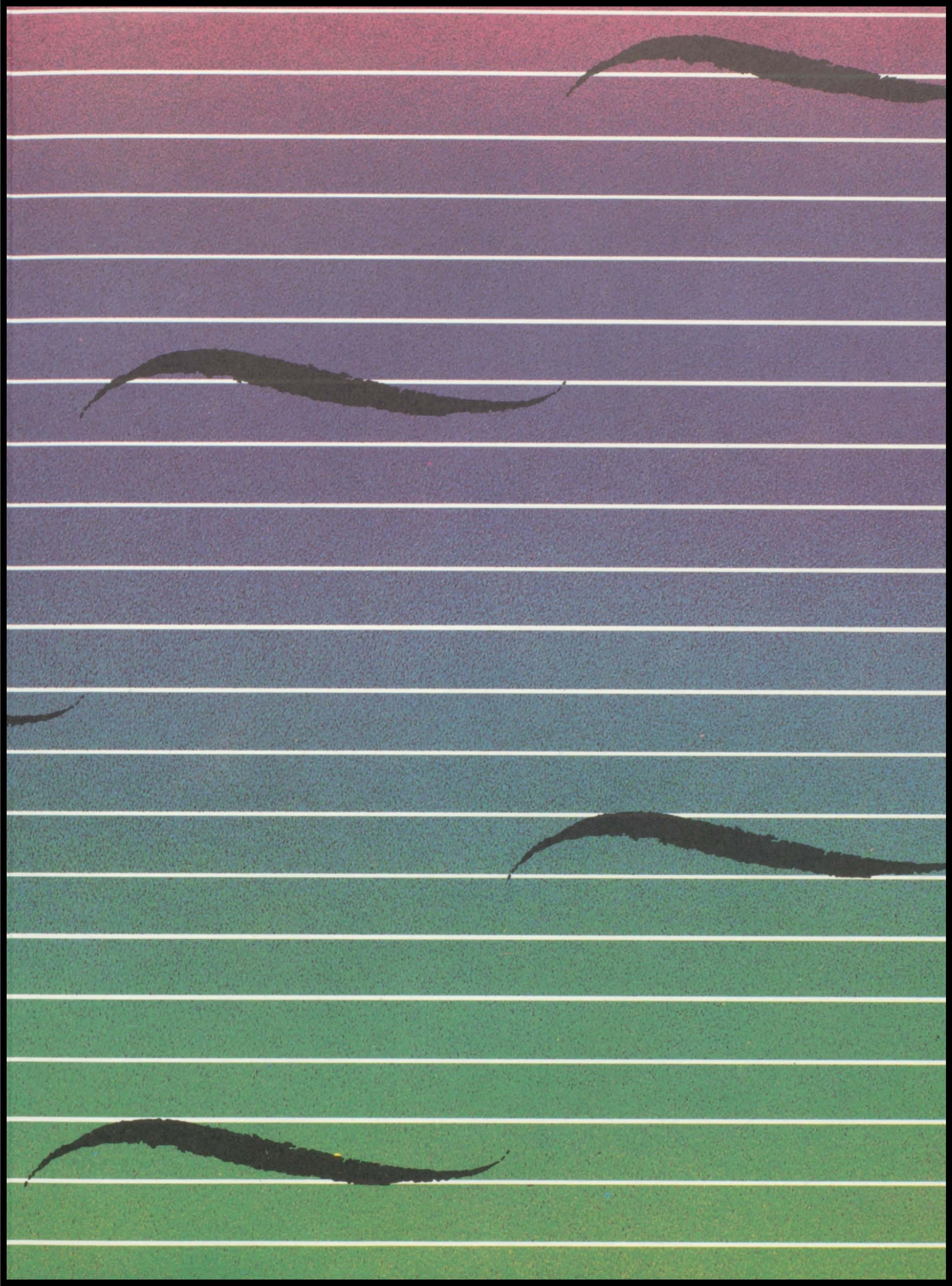


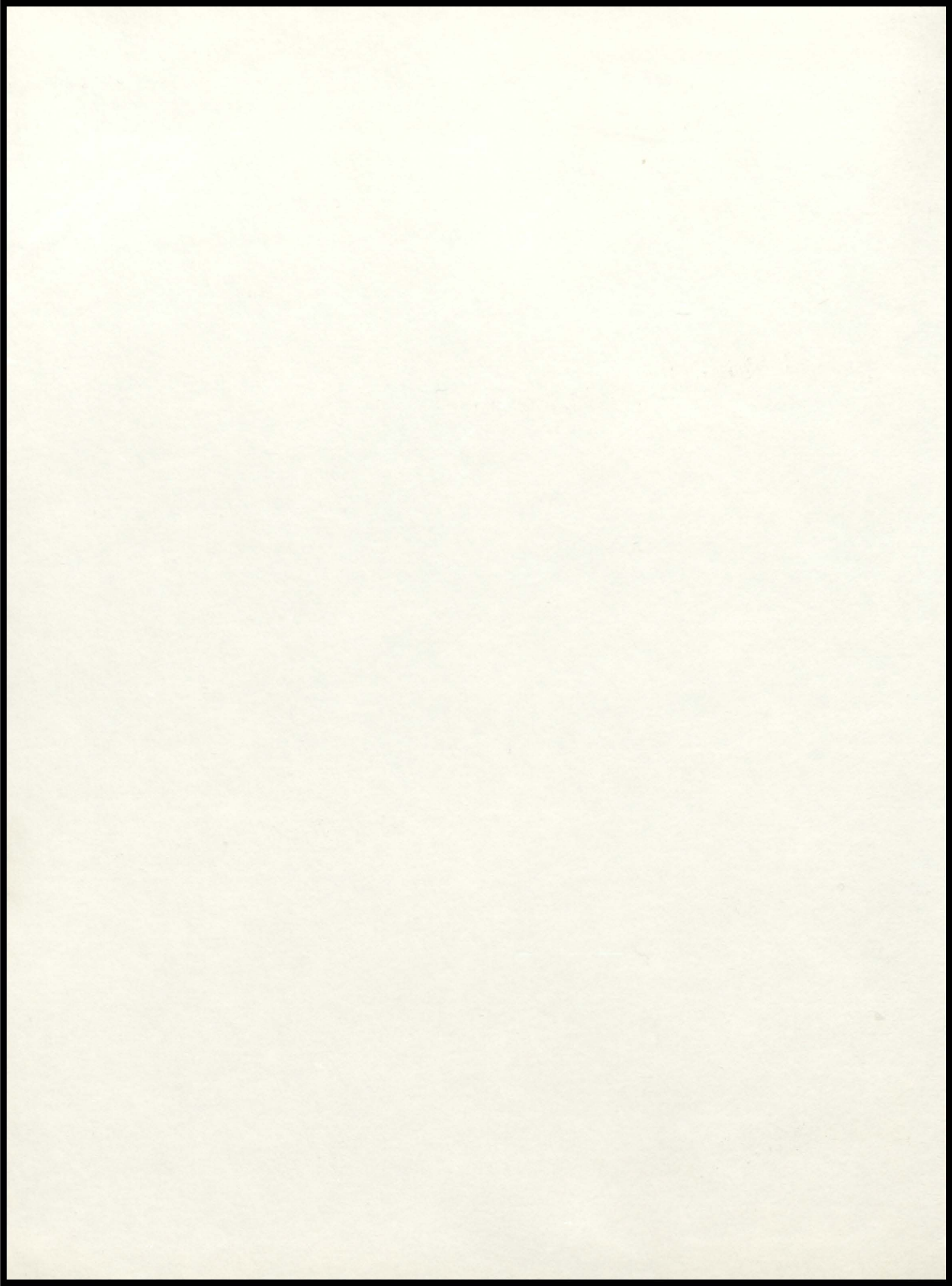

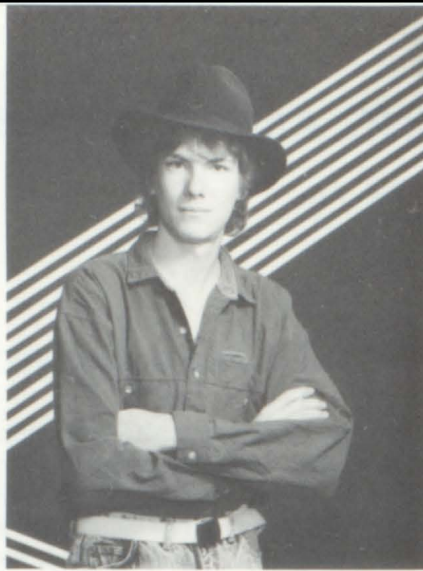
The next day, they fixed the ship and finished their reunion on the Virgin Islands.

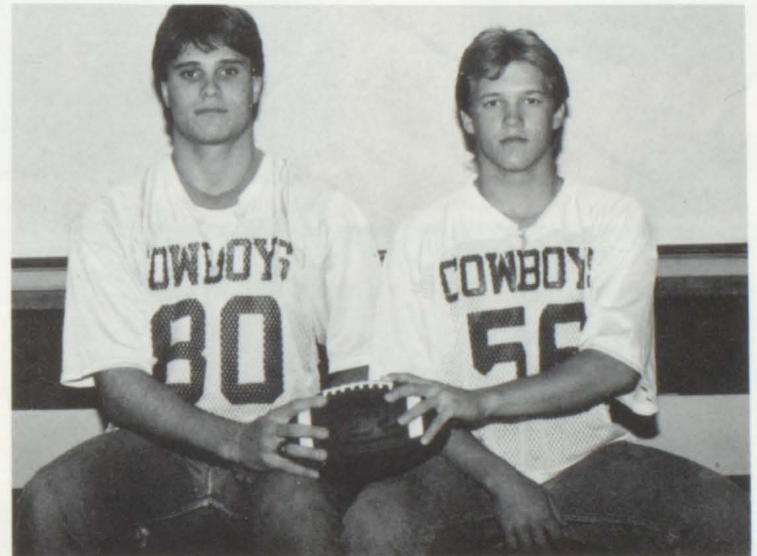

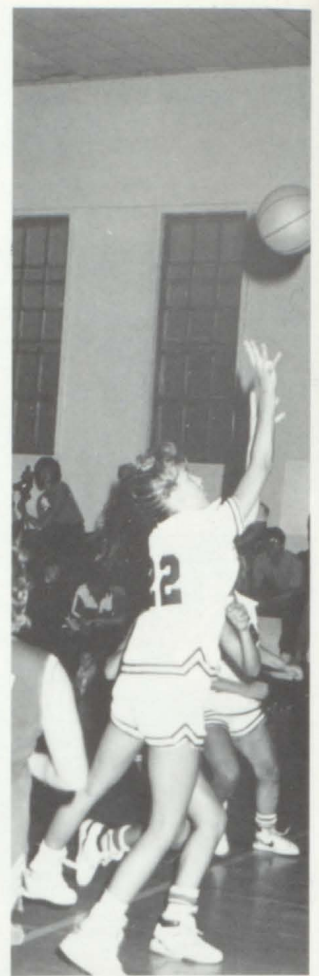
COWGIRLS SHOOT THE HOOP

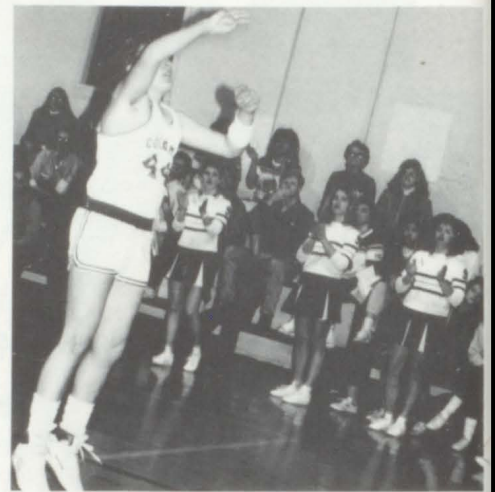
