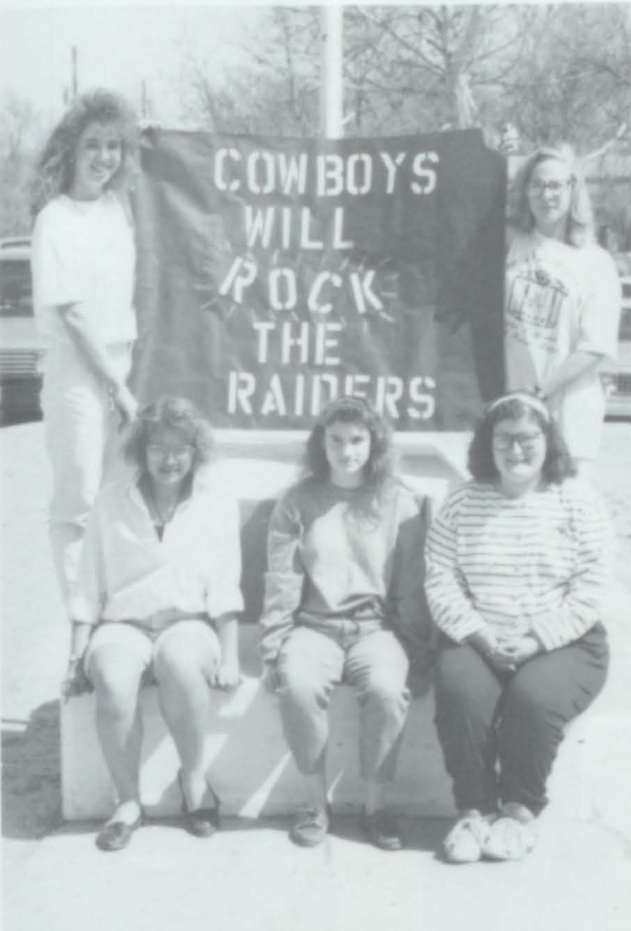

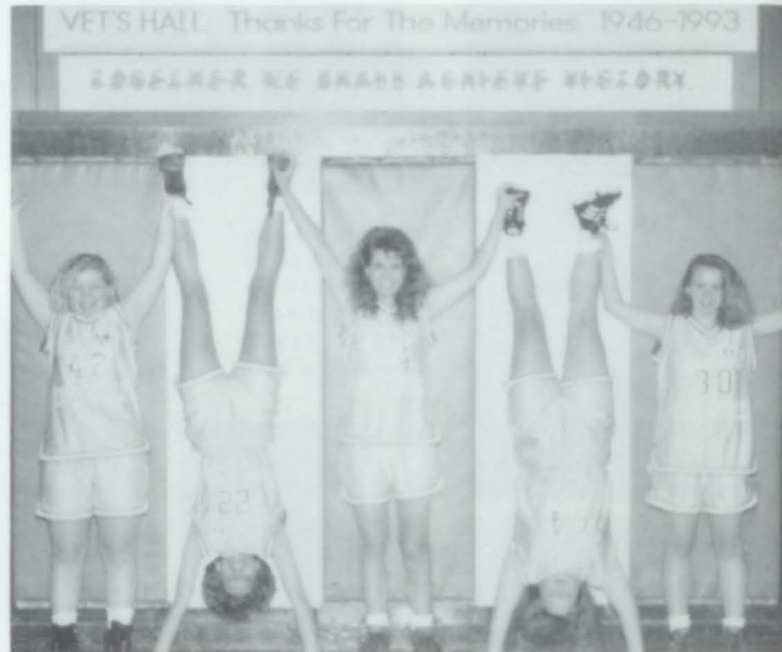


Girls Basketball
