"TOGETHER!", gave us a lot of victories and a lot of memories. We will always remember the 1993 COWGIRLS.



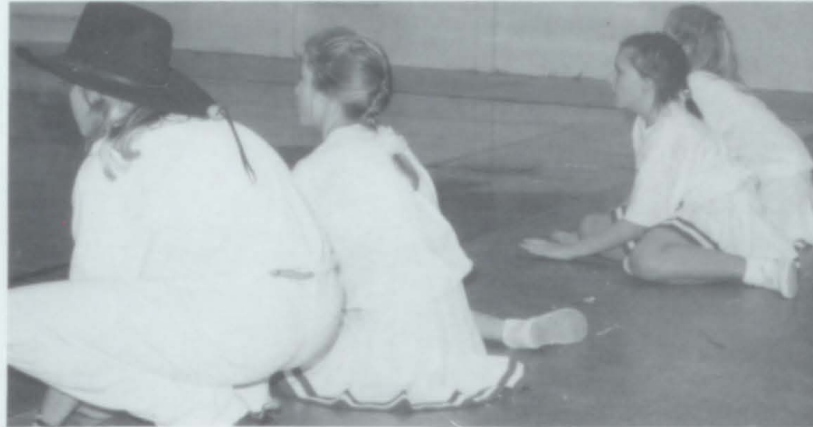

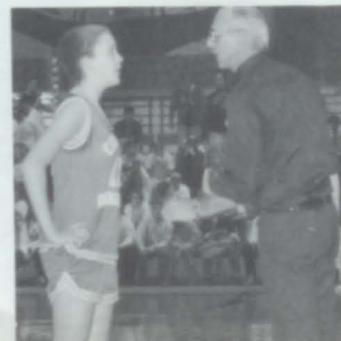


**THE DREAM TEAM
